Overview:

Reli's Six pack is a fun, interactive game based on six open-ended questions crafted around a theme. Open-ended questions enable respondents to

- go deep on a specific topic
- give more meaningful answers

- build a growth mindset and personal responsibility
- nurture critical thinking skills
- learn how to ask the right questions

How to play

Recommended group size is 3 to 10 individuals. For more than 10 people to play the game, we suggest splitting into two or more groups and each group plays with their own Reli's Six Pack cube.

Roll the die and respond to the question/activity corresponding to the number rolled. If you get the same number as the person before you, roll the die again. Avoid repeating an answer that another group member has given. Once everyone has had one round, the game is over. If after one round some numbers have not been played, have another round. To make the game longer, have as many rounds until everyone has answered all six questions.

The Questions

- 1 Risk Awareness: What are the most common natural disasters or emergencies in your area? How aware are community members of the risks they face, and what steps can be taken to improve awareness?
- **2 Preparedness Planning:** What are the essential items, information and protocols every household should have in their emergency kit, and do you have them readily available?
- **3 Community Resilience:** How can your community foster resilience in the face of disasters? How can social connections and community networks be strengthened to support recovery efforts including psychological and emotional impacts?
- **4 Technological Solutions:** How can technology be leveraged to improve disaster preparedness, early warning systems, and communication during emergencies? What are the potential risks and challenges associated with relying on technology in disaster response?
- 5 Climate Resilience: What adaptation strategies can communities implement to build resilience to climate-related hazards? How can disaster preparedness efforts contribute to broader sustainability and climate resilience goals?
- **6 Vision 20/20:** Share a disaster you have experienced in the past and the lessons you have you learned from it. How can we apply these lessons to improve future preparedness and response efforts?
